PRIDE OF OWNERSHIP AWARD

We are holding a Pride of Ownership award in addition to the usual concours (Townshend) Trophy at the Easter Rally. This will be judged on the Sunday at the car display.

The 'Pride of Ownership' awards takes into account the age of the vehicle, its condition and originality. It would, for instance, look favourably on a 'survivor' vehicle, with its original paintwork, patina and (for example) whether it had its original factory stickers under the bonnet, boot and even the original supplying dealer's sticker or badge.

Other items that will be taken into account are cleanliness of the vehicle, both inside and out, including inside the boot and under the bonnet as well as the tyres and wheels.

If the owner has the original (or copy) of the registration papers, owner's manuals, sales brochures or period accessories, these will also be taken into account.

Essentially, we are looking for good, honest survivor vehicles, not trailer queens. You will be displaying pride of ownership in your vehicle.
